INTRODUCTION

Dear Reader:

It is an odd pleasure to welcome you to this stark compilation of statistics. Deathly dull, dry, lifeless numbers. Columns of them.

But virtually every one of us who cracks the cover of this book and lingers over the meaning of these numbers ought to feel some pride. For we all contributed to this work. It is we -- all of us -- who are responsible for creating these figures. By our separate actions on November 3, 1992, we built this book as we made our individual choices about who should represent and lead us.

So, we should celebrate this book -- not necessarily to honor the winners of the hundreds of races summarized here -- but to honor the process, the discussion, the individual investments of time, energy and thought which collectively produced these results.

More Vermonters than ever before voted in 1992. Seventy-six percent of those who were registered, and seventy percent of those who were eligible took the time and made the effort to practice our birthright. We voted in significant enough numbers to rank Vermont fifth among the 50 United States in percentage turnout. Of that we should be proud.

"Democracy counts . . . on your vote" shouts a popular slogan. And in Vermont, more than most other places, an individual vote can make a difference to the outcome. In 1992 we had seven races that were so close that a recount was required before a winner could be certified. One of those recounts in the Rutland-2 representative district resulted in a tie. The final result had to be determined by a run-off election on December 15.

Do not attempt to devour this book in one sitting. Peruse it. Ponder it. Play with the hypotheses it invites . . . and resists. Above all, feast on this compilation and celebration of participatory democracy in Vermont.
